

# Dinosaur Boogie

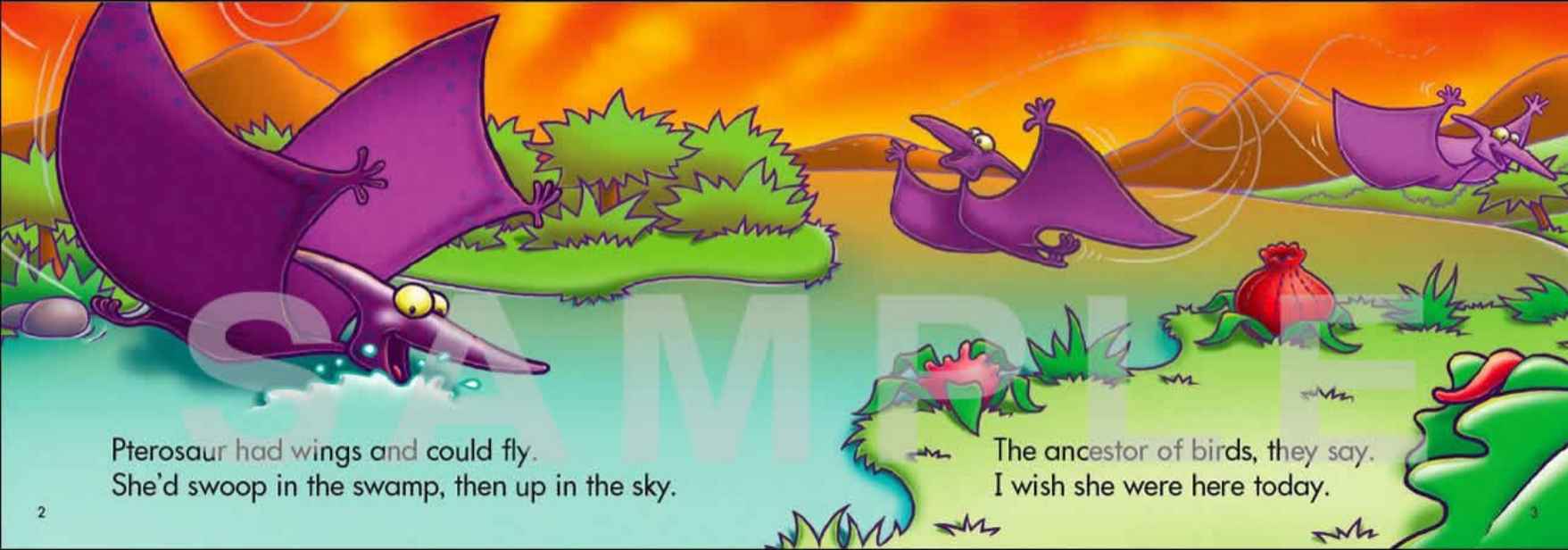
Dinosaur Boogie

I wish she were here today.



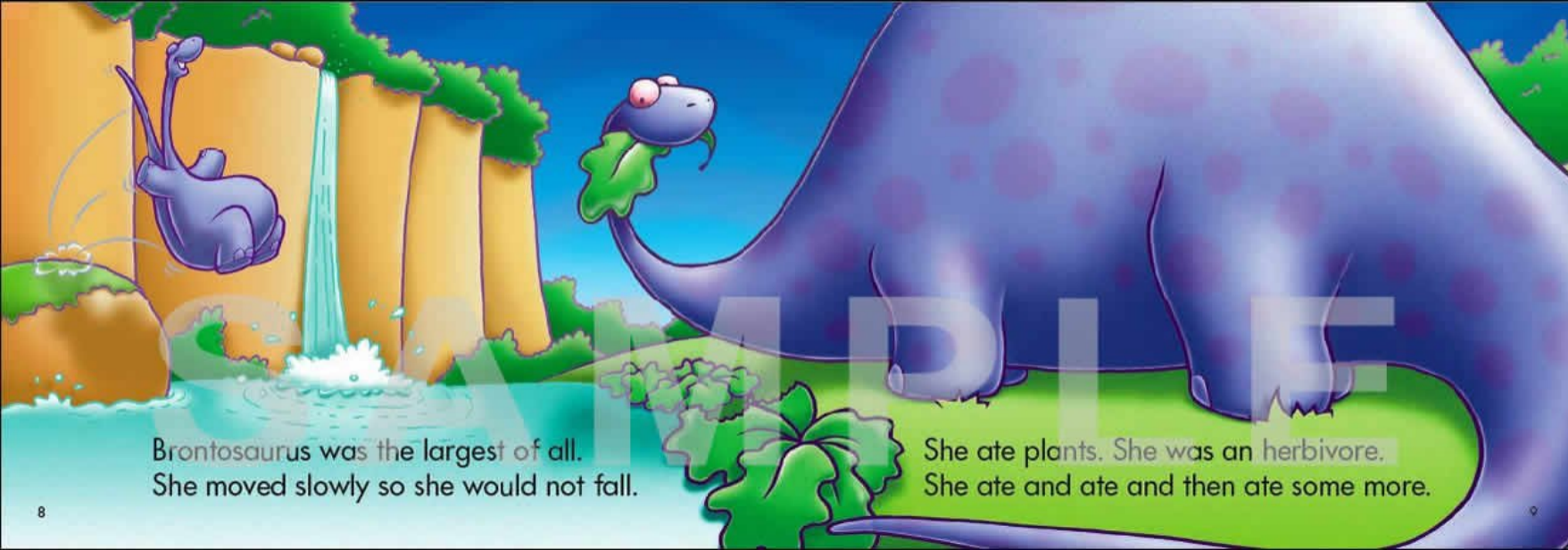
Tyrannosaurus Rex, king of the swamp.
