

Directions: Trace all of the gray lines on the birthday cake. Color the cake.


Cutting Practice

Tropical Trees



Directions: Group children into threes or fours. Give each group 6 sheets of newspaper to stack. Starting at the short side, have the students roll the newspaper into a tube about 2" (5 cm) in diameter. Tape the middle and bottom of the tube. Make four 6" (15 cm) cuts into the top of the tube. Reach inside and gently pull the inside strips up and out. Paint the trees and add birds, butterflies, fruit, or flowers. Stand the trees in coffee cans filled with sand or crumpled newspaper.
