Declarative (telling) sentences end with periods.

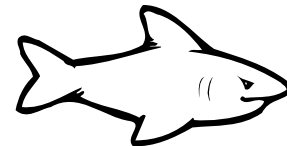

Punctuation Rule: Use commas to separate items in a series.


Each box below has pictures of three items. List the items in the box in a series. Be sure to separate the items with commas.




