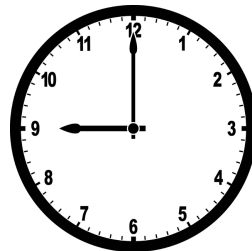
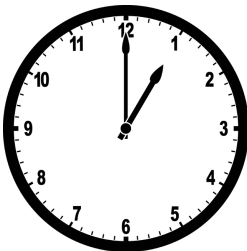


Justin raced Legend cars in North Carolina while living in Pennsylvania. He had to travel a long way each week to race. Connect the dots on the map to create his road map.
