

There are two different types of dog patterns from which to choose - black/white and color. If you wish to have students color and decorate the dogs as well as write on the bones, use the black and white dogs from pages 4-9. If you are in a time crunch or just wish students to focus on the writing, use the color dog patterns from pages 10-15.


There are also two different writing options from which to choose.

Option I: The sentence starter is "During the summer I like to" (pages 4-6 & 10-12). Have students finish the sentence with activities that they like to do during the summer months. They can also draw pictures to illustrate their sentences. This option is perfect for the end of the school year, during summer school or summer camp programs, etc.
