






Letter Match in the Pumpkin Patch



Fire Safety Bulletin Board Directions

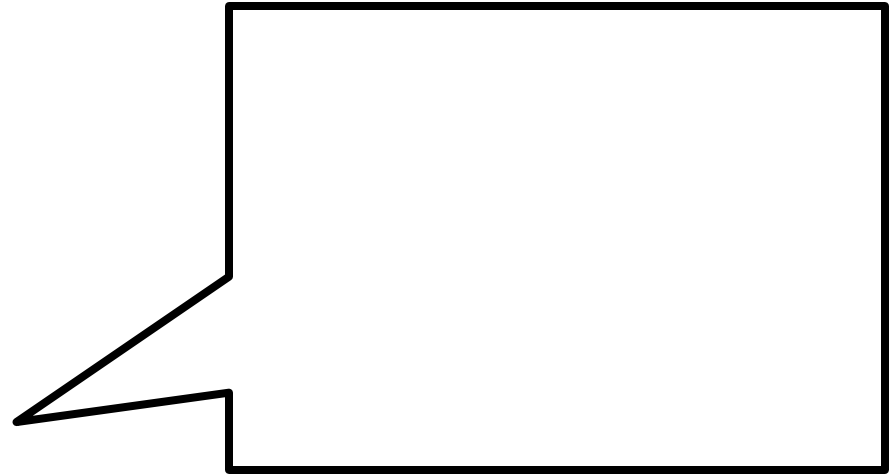
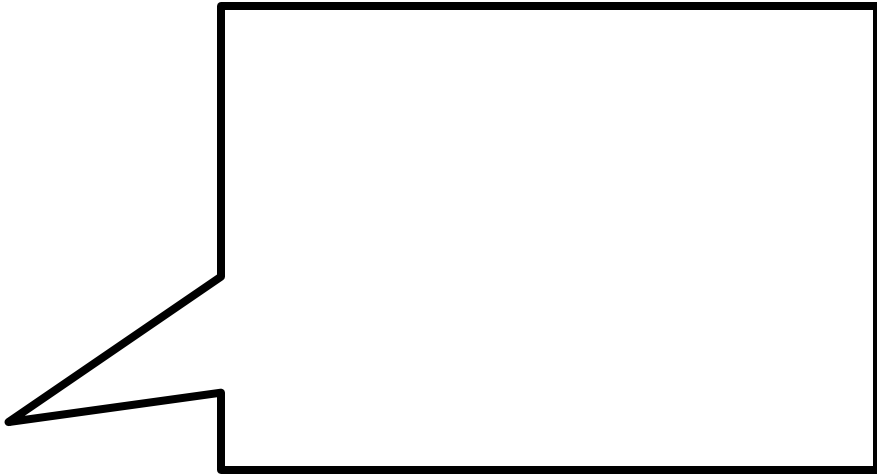
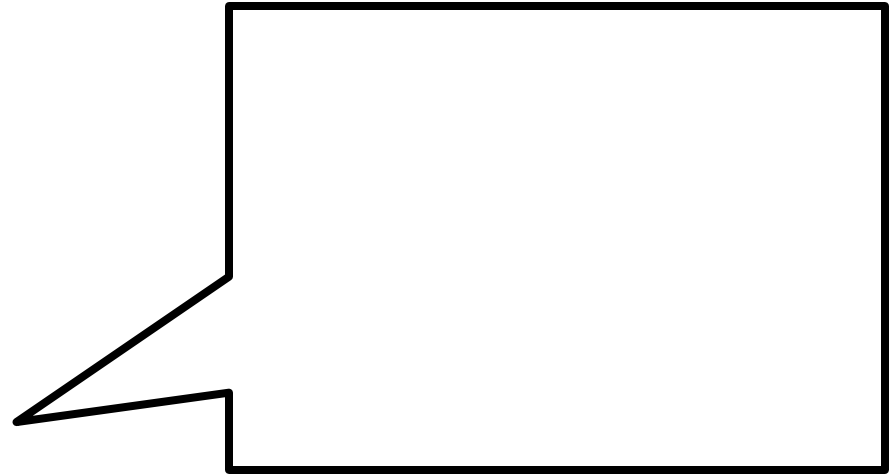
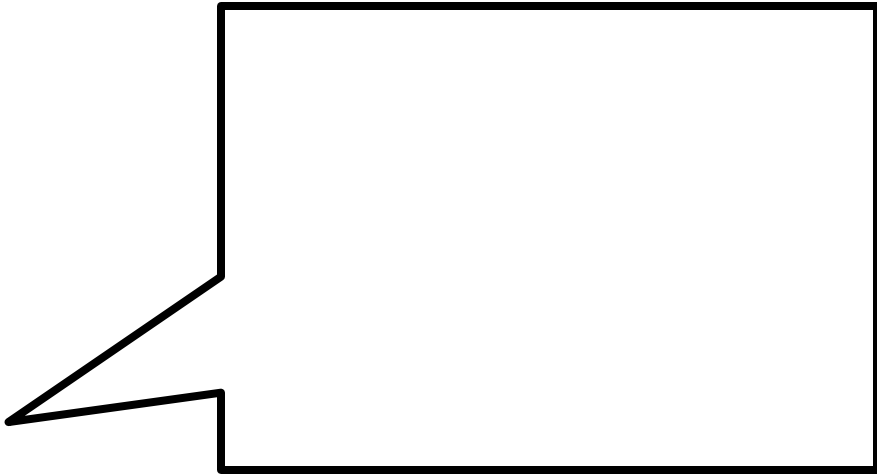
Print a fire dog and speech bubble for each student.

Have students either dip their fingers in black paint and put fingerprint dots on their dogs OR use black bingo dabbers to put black spots on their dogs OR color black dots on their dogs. Students can also color the fire hat if desired.

Give each student a speech bubble and have them write one fire safety rule or tip they learned and sign their name.

Hang the fire dogs along with their speech bubbles on a bulletin board or on a wall and title it "Look Who Was Spotted Learning Fire Safety".
