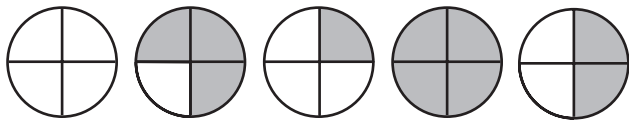

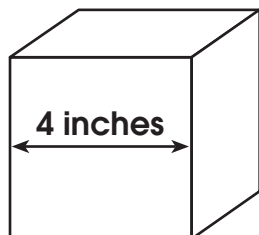
Think about how the figures in the first picture are related. Use the same relationship to draw the missing figure in the second picture.
