Point to your ears.

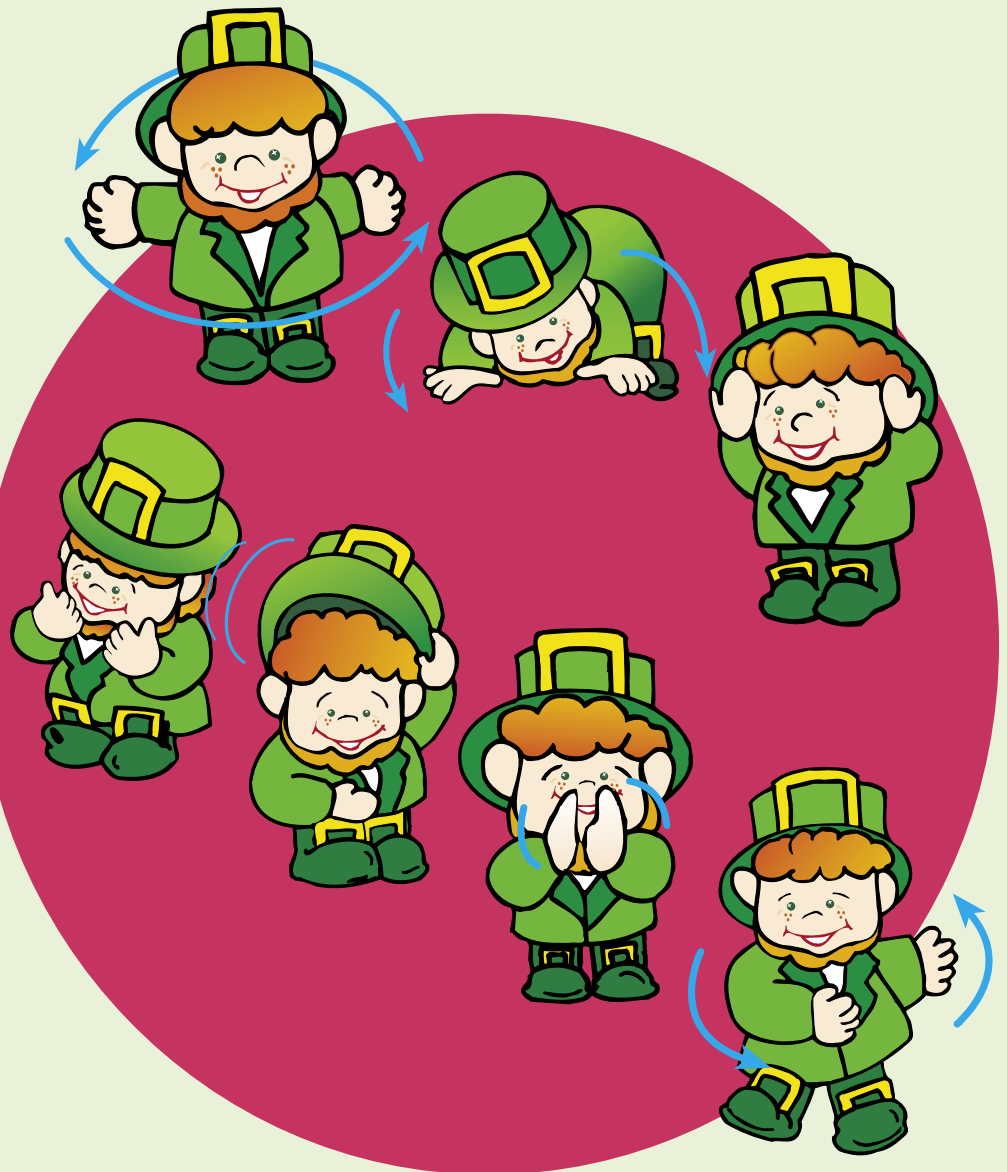
Leprechaun, leprechaun,
