

Let's Go!

Booklet Materials:

copy of pages 8–11 and the booklet page on page 12 for each student
crayons
scissors
glue
stapler

Making the booklet:

1. Cut out the cover and booklet pages.
2. Stack the booklet pages in order behind the cover; then staple them together along the left-hand side.
3. Have the student write his name on the cover.
4. Have him color the pictures on the cover and booklet pages.



Introducing the featured words:

Introduce the words listed by writing them on the board and discussing them. Or, if desired, pack in some fun by using a suitcase to introduce the words! To do this, write the featured high-frequency words on separate index cards. Then put all the cards in a small suitcase or overnight bag. Show youngsters the bag and ask a volunteer to remove a card from the suitcase. Help him identify the word; then display it for the class. Continue in this manner with different students until all the words have been identified. Then enjoy the booklet together.

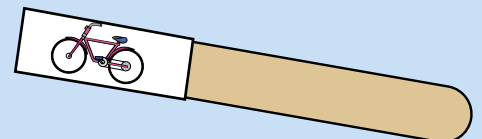
Building fluency:

When students have read through the booklet several times, get them on the right track with these vehicle pointers! Give each child a copy of a vehicle pattern on page 12. Have each child color his pattern; then help him glue the cutout vertically to a craft stick to make a pointer as shown. Have him reread the booklet, using the vehicle pointer to travel across the pages!

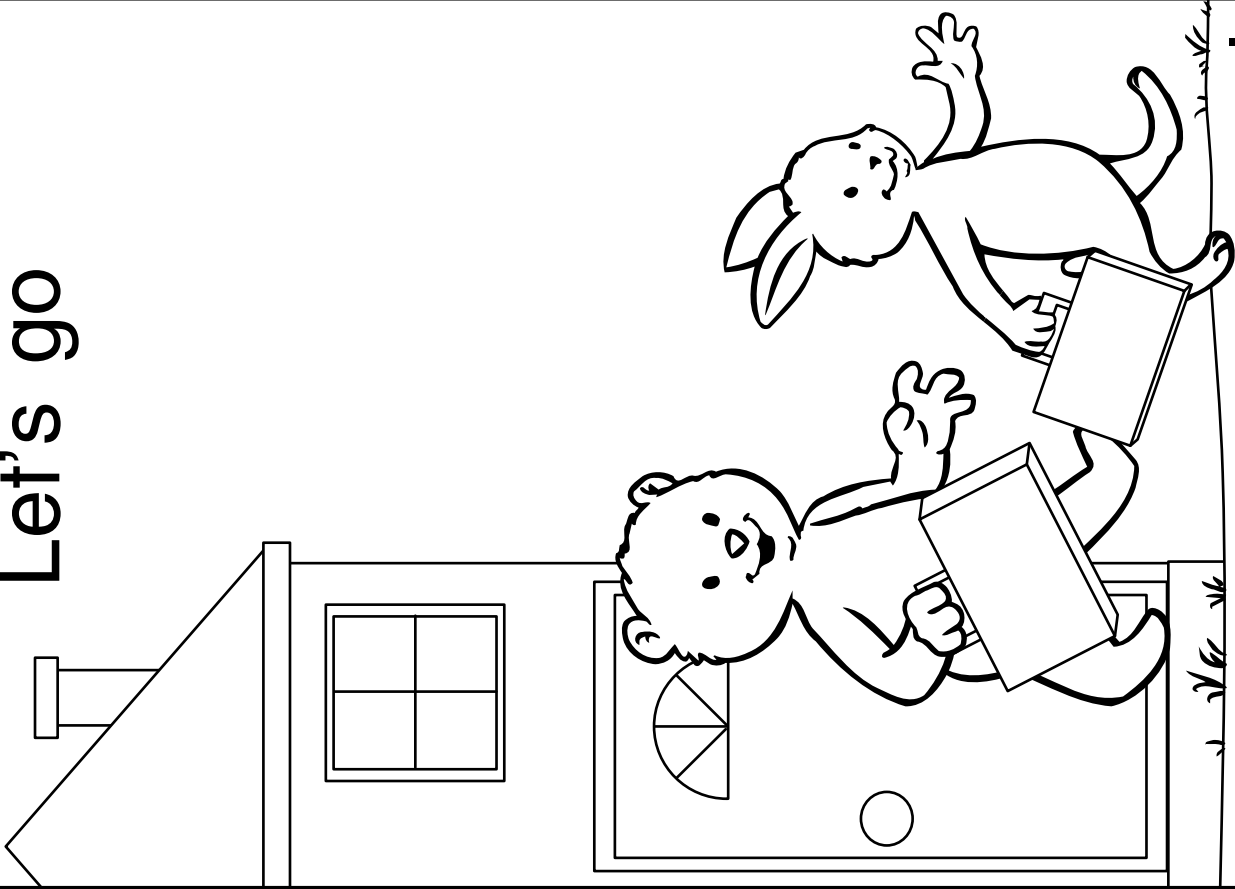

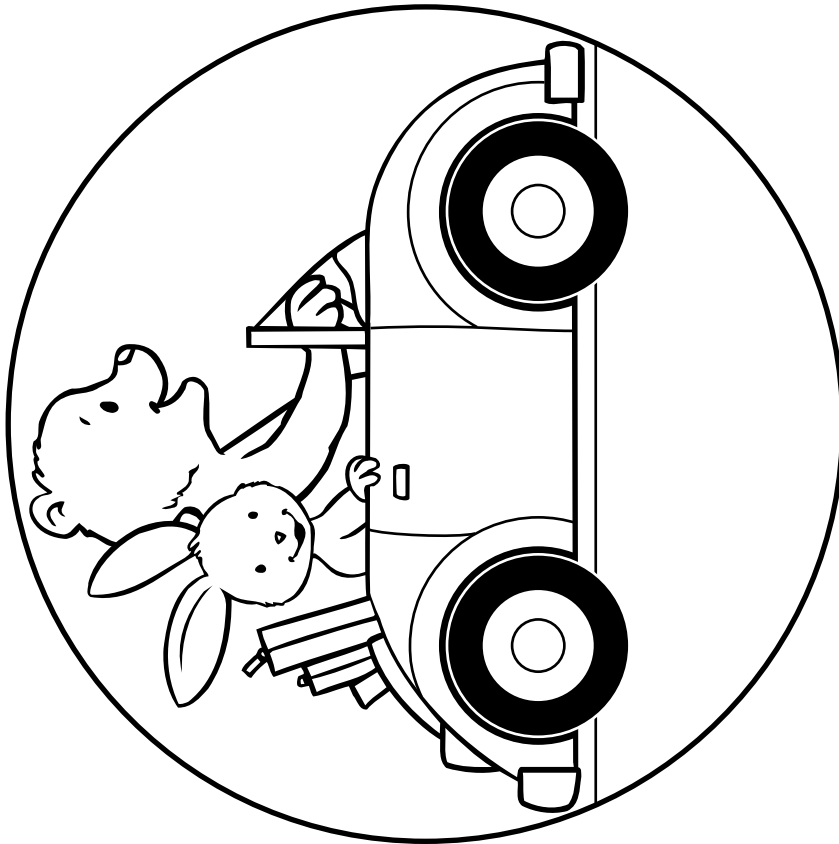
Booklet Cover and Page 1
